CTEC Dual Enrollment Policy

CTEC allows students to earn college credits throughout their high school careers. We understand that college courses can be challenging and sometimes lead to unfortunate grades. CTEC has created a new policy for our students to maintain good standing with Fresno City (listed below). A letter is also being sent home that further explains the policy changes. If you have any questions, feel free to contact CTEC.

- 1. The student MUST maintain a high school GPA of 2.0 on the semester grade reports.
- 2. The student MUST complete at least 50% of the college courses attempted with a "C" or better.
- 3. Suppose a student fails the first semester of a course that offers dual enrollment in the second semester (i.e., Biology, English 12, US History, etc.). In that case, they will not be eligible to dual enroll for the course in the second semester.

General Reminders
