### Snack Bar Every Friday

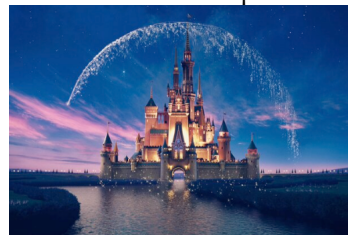

## General Reminders

### Parking Permit

To park on campus, students must complete a parking permit application & provide a copy of their driver's license & car insurance to Mrs. Moua. They will be issued a parking permit and can park on campus when those items are turned in. Seniors are the only students allowed to leave campus during lunch if they maintain the required GPA and turn in the necessary paperwork. If your student is driving themselves to an appointment, a parent must call attendance to give permission.
