Based on the Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACS WASC) mid-cycle visit, it has been determined that Career Technical Education Charter (9-12) meets the ACS WASC criteria for accreditation. This accreditation status is based on all of the information provided by the school, including the school's progress report, and the satisfactory completion of the mid-cycle accreditation visit.

Career Technical Education Charter's accreditation is now reaffirmed through the end of the current accreditation cycle ending on June 30, 2028.
